### **Award Highlights:**

- San Francisco State University professor Mihaela Mihailova is researching deepfakes in contemporary media. Her project is focused on the aesthetics, application, dissemination, and ontological status of deepfakes across media contexts, including digital artworks, social activism, museum exhibits, and film and television.
- The San Diego Air and Space Museum is increasing online access to its expansive catalog. They are cataloging, rehousing, and digitization 120,000 image negatives from the Convair collection, which documents aerospace projects and workers from 1923 to 1996, as well as updating the collection's related finding aid.
