Award Highlights:

- The Foundation for Advancement in Conservation will further develop its Sustainability Tools in Cultural Heritage (STiCH) Carbon Calculator. The calculator is a computational analysis and modeling platform that assists heritage professionals in determining the carbon footprint of the materials used for the preservation and exhibition of cultural resources.
- The National Building Museum created a new long-term exhibit titled Building Stories. The exhibit explores the built environments in children's books and how those worlds lay the foundations for how we understand our surroundings.

NEH also provides annual funding to [HumanitiesDC](#), the designated humanities council in the district, to support a wide array of public programming.

Recent HumanitiesDC Highlights:

- The new Community Journalism Program allows DC residents to identify, report and produce the stories that matter most to their communities. Participants engaged in a series of workshops, received in-the-field training from professional journalists, and were supported through the writing process, resulting in many of the pieces produced being featured in local news outlets.
- The council partnered with the international documentary festival DC/DOX to create DC[FRAME], a program that features local filmmakers telling stories that demonstrate a deep resonance with the city.
