Grants to New York Organizations and Individuals for Fiscal Year 2019 through 2023 – \$ 104,739,397

Total Number of Awards – 680

Award Highlights:

- Funding was granted by the Research Foundation for the State University of New York to develop digital humanities materials, an advanced course, and a community-wide speaker series for the study and instruction of Spanish language and culture for heritage speakers.
- A grant was awarded to the University of Buffalo to conduct research and create an online publication that examines the ways in which land use in Bali's Alas Merta Jati forest can be described using satellite imagery, geographic information systems, and artificial intelligence, as well as the ways in which these descriptions interact with traditional knowledge and sustainability tactics.

NEH also provides annual funding to the [New York Humanities Council](#), the designated humanities council in the state, to support a wide array of public programming.
